- 4. Tweet this photo at your representatives. You can search for your rep's Twitter handle using the search function on the mobile app. Most representatives' official accounts will have the verified blue check mark next to their name.
- 5. You can also post your photo on your Facebook page and "tag" your representative. To do that, use the @ symbol and start typing their name [example: @ted cruz]. You'll see a selection of people with that name. Choose your rep from the list. Then tag the Center for Biological Diversity.
