



Local Measures to Stop Fracking

As of July 2014 the following communities have moved forward to stop fracking locally.

- **Los Angeles:** On February 28, 2014 the City Council unanimously voted to draft a moratorium on fracking.
- **Butte County:** On April 8, 2014 the Butte County Board of Supervisors voted to draft an ordinance banning fracking.
- **San Juan Bautista:** On April 15, 2014 the San Juan Bautista City Council considered a ban, which is expected to come to a vote in late 2014.
- **Compton:** On April 22, 2014 the Compton City Council passed an indefinite moratorium.
- **Beverly Hills:** On May 6, 2014 the Beverly Hills City Council passed a ban.
- **Santa Cruz County:** On May 20, 2014 the Santa Cruz Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to ban fracking.
- **Monterey County:** The Board of Supervisors is expected to vote on a moratorium in September 2014.
- **Santa Barbara County:** An initiative to ban fracking and similar techniques will be on the November ballot.
- **San Benito County:** An initiative to ban fracking and similar techniques will be on the November ballot.
- **Mendocino County:** A rights-based measure to ban fracking will be on the November ballot.
