Subject: Public Records Act Request (PR# 22/23 L-25)

Dear Ms. Brown:

On December 2, 2022, the Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) received your Public Records Act (PRA) request by email transmission, specifically requesting that DPR conduct a records search and/or make copies of records related to information about which California-registered adjuvants have fluorinated ingredients (molecules that contain a fluorine atom) which have been disclosed to DPR.

We appreciate your patience in waiting for a response to your request. DPR staff within the Chemistry Program reviewed the product formulations (capturing both the principle functioning agents as well as the inert ingredients) for all adjuvants currently registered in California. Based on the data available, DPR has concluded that it does not have any records in hard copy or electronic format that are responsive to your request, because there are no adjuvant products currently registered by DPR which contain fluorinated chemical ingredients.
