Comments: We have been reading about the Seresto dog collars causing deaths in some pets. We feel like this is what happened to our Sheltie. He worn these collars for several years. He was only 7 years old and in the last 6 months of his

life, he was not as healthy as before. But we could not find out why. Then on Dec. 8 around 6 pm, he started vomiting and would not stop.

He got so weak he could not stand. We called our vet and was on the way to the clinic with him, he had a seizure and died in my arms before We could get there. The vet checked him over and could not find a reason for his death.

He kept asking if he could have gotten into any poison, but he did not and could not. After reading all the news articles about other dogs dying from wearing these Seresto collars, we feel sure this is what happened to our dog also. We do not know any other way to submit a complaint or if this is the proper way to state the facts about our dog. Please let us know if there is something else that we can do to raise our concerns.
