Religious group teams with conservationists to save endangered toad

SANTA BARBARA, Calif. Conservationists working to save the arroyo toad in Santa Barbara County could be getting some holy help.

A religious group has joined in a lawsuit demanding that the federal government do more to help the endangered amphibian _ and they say they will also pray for the toad.

Christians Caring for Creation is a nationwide prayer network with headquarters in Pasadena. It has joined together with the Arizona-based Center for Biological Diversity in challenging a critical habitat designation for the toad issued by the Fish and Wildlife Service in April.
