

# Californian Environmentalists Propose To Consider White Sharks as Endangered

It's a call for saving these white sharks, which should be included in the endangered species category! Majority of the northern Californian environmentalists have collaborated and raising concerns over the protection of white sharks.

They have decided that they will be putting up the matter in front of state and federal government and ask them to include the species in [the list](#) and deploy highest level of regulatory protection.

Monreyer group Oceana and the San Francisco-based Centre for Biological Diversity have filed the petition with federal National Marine Fisheries Service.

In case the federal agency supports the petition and implements it, then also it would take almost more than a year.

"Our goal is the federal agency lists the US West Coast population of great white sharks as endangered, seeking added conservation measures, particularly when it comes to [drift](#) net and gill net fisheries", says Ashley Blacow, a spokeswoman for Oceana.

Miyoko Sakashita, Centre for Biological Diversity's oceans director, asserted that the [technologies](#) and science are day by day advancing. If the sharks are included in the list, then it would help them provide with a protected habitat.

Already California has imposed a ban on [commercial](#) use of the sharks and [the practice](#) is also illegal along western US.
